





To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Henry Dreyfuss, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Photographic Camera, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the front and one side of a photographic camera in an operative position, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view of the same in a non-operative position; and

Fig. 3 is a perspective view showing the front

and the opposite side of Fig. 1 but in the non-operative position as in Fig. 2.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a photographic camera, substantially as shown and described.
